Fairhavens works closely with Durban Child Welfare to provide a safe home for abandoned babies until they can be placed into a secure family environment.



feeding programme

Indlela's feeding programme operates from two industrial kitchens which provide food for thousands of hungry children in schools and crèches in the Durban North and Amaoti communities every day.



life skills initiatives

Indlela's Life Skills and HIV prevention programmes have proved effective in instilling a sense of self-worth and hope in vulnerable children. In order to help maximize their educational potential, homework and holiday clubs are offered as well as a literacy programme. On a practical level, work parties are arranged to assist with much-needed repairs and renovations to schools.
